CUCKOOING

is when criminals take over a vulnerable person's home and use it:

- To deal, store or take drugs
- For sexual or financial exploitation
- To hide weapons or stolen goods
 - As a place to stay

Know the signs



Gardens are overgrown

Piles of takeaway boxes or containers



Drug manufacturing and dealing paraphernalia



Locks on internal doors



Weapons and expensive items



Children or adults that have no clear connection to the resident



CCTV equipment



Damage to doors or windows



Curtains and blinds are closed during the day

The resident may:

- Provide accounts of how injuries have occurred which seem rehearsed
- Avoid eye contact

- Be carrying multiple mobile phones
- Present as angry, anxious, fearful or withdrawn
